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RULES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTER CLASS PARTICIPATION

REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS AND PRESCREENING: Singers shall submit at least two (2) and up to five (5) art songs composed for voice and piano accompaniment on their applications for presentation in a master class setting. All five (5) selections should meet the requirements of the master class' focus or theme (i.e., all submissions for the "Female Composers" master class must be compositions by women). Singers whose repertoire submissions do not meet the requirements may not be considered for participation. ASPS requires a prescreening recording of one (1) of the song selections from the master class application (please indicate on the application which song will serve as your audio submission). If you apply for more than one master class, you must submit an audio sample for each of the master classes for which you wish to be considered. Audio samples should be submitted by CD along with other application materials.

SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS: In addition to their completed application, singers must submit their audio samples (CD or DVD), their \$25 Master Application fee, and a current headshot.

PARTICIPANT NOTIFICATION: Singers selected to participate in ASPS master classes will be notified via telephone and/or email no later than two (2) weeks before the workshop event. All singers selected to participate must confirm their participation within 48 hours of notification, or they risk losing their position in the master class.

ACCOMPANISTS: A pianist will be available to all singers selected for participation in ASPS master classes for a fee of \$25; however, singers who wish to bring and perform with their own pianists may do so.
